

# LARVATE

*Meaning: LARVATE: to undergo the process of developing into a larva or entering a larval stage.*

1. The scientists discovered that the larvae would larvate in the damp soil during the rainy season.
2. After several weeks, the caterpillars began to larvate, transforming into their pupal stage.
3. In order to observe the life cycle, the students set up an aquarium where they could watch the insects larvate.
