

LECTIONARY

Meaning: Lectionary: a book or schedule containing a collection of scripture readings designated for use in public worship services.

1. The church's lectionary includes a carefully curated selection of scripture readings for each Sunday.
2. During the service, the pastor referred to the lectionary to guide the congregation through the day's readings.
3. Many congregations use a three-year cycle of the lectionary to ensure a broad exposure to biblical texts.
4. The use of a lectionary helps to structure worship and encourages deeper engagement with the Bible.
5. In preparation for the sermon, the priest spent time reflecting on the themes presented in the lectionary.
