Meaning: LESSEE: A person or entity that leases or rents property from another party, known as the lessor, and is responsible for its maintenance during the lease term.

1. The lessee is responsible for maintaining the property in good condition throughout the lease term.
2. Before signing the agreement, the lessee should thoroughly review the terms and conditions outlined in the lease.
3. In many cases, a lessee may negotiate specific clauses to better suit their needs before finalizing the contract.
4. The landlord must provide the lessee with all necessary information regarding the property and its usage.
5. If the lessee fails to pay rent on time, they risk facing penalties or even eviction.

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
