Meaning: Let-up: a reduction or pause in intensity or severity of something, such as pressure or adverse conditions.

1. The relentless rain showed no let-up, leaving the streets flooded and hazardous.
2. After weeks of hard work, he finally felt a let-up in the pressure to meet deadlines.
3. Despite the initial let-up in hostilities, tensions remained high between the two factions.
4. She hoped for a let-up in the heatwave so that they could enjoy their outdoor plans.
5. There was a brief let-up in the noise from the construction site, providing a moment of peace.
