

LIBELER

Meaning: Libeler: a person who makes false and defamatory statements about another, typically in written form.

1. The journalist was accused of being a libeler after publishing false information about the celebrity.
2. In the courtroom, the defense lawyer argued that her client was not a libeler, but rather a whistleblower exposing corruption.
3. A libeler may face serious legal consequences for spreading defamatory statements about another person.
4. The author faced backlash for being labeled a libeler after writing a controversial book based on unverified claims.
5. To prove someone is a libeler, one must show that the statements made were both false and damaging to their reputation.
