Meaning: A licensee is an individual or entity that has been granted permission to use a specific asset, such as a trademark or intellectual property, under the terms of a licensing agreement.

1. The licensee must adhere to all regulations set forth in the agreement.
2. As a licensee, she is granted permission to use the trademark in her marketing materials.
3. The company revoked the license of the previous licensee due to multiple violations.
4. Each licensee is responsible for ensuring that their products meet safety standards.
5. The software license agreement clearly outlines the rights and obligations of the licensee.
