

LIMONITE

Meaning: Limonite is a brownish iron ore composed mainly of hydrated iron(III) oxide, commonly found in sedimentary environments and formed from the weathering of iron-rich minerals.

1. Limonite is often found in sedimentary environments where iron-rich minerals have weathered.
2. Geologists frequently study limonite to understand the history of iron deposits in a region.
3. The yellow-brown color of limonite makes it easily distinguishable from other iron ores.
4. Limonite can be an important source of iron for industrial applications.
5. In many cases, limonite forms from the oxidation of pyrite and other iron-bearing minerals.

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
