1. The old dog was limpingly making its way to the porch.
2. She entered the room limpingly, clearly in pain from her injured ankle.
3. After the race, he walked limpingly, his leg cramping from the exertion.
4. The soldier returned home limpingly, a reminder of the battles he had faced.
5. He approached the finish line limpingly, determined to complete the marathon despite his injury.
