Meaning: LINEARLY: In a manner that follows a straight line or a consistent, proportional relationship, often used to describe changes or trends that occur at a constant rate.

3. The growth of the plant was measured linearly, showing consistent progress each week.
4. Her performance improved linearly as she practiced more frequently.
5. The equation describes how the two variables are related linearly.
