

# LIQUESCENT

*Meaning: Liquescent (adjective): having the quality of becoming liquid or fluid, especially when heated.*

1. The liquescent state of the wax made it easy to mold into intricate shapes.

3. In the lab, the liquescent gel was used to create a smooth surface for the experiment.
