

LITERALIST

Meaning: A literalist is a person who interprets words and phrases in their most basic, straightforward sense, often overlooking deeper meanings or figurative language.

1. The poet's use of metaphor was lost on the literalist, who could only interpret the words at face value.
2. As a literalist, she struggled to appreciate the nuances of irony in the comedian's routine.
3. In debates about literature, he often clashed with literalists who dismissed the deeper meanings behind the texts.
4. Her literalist approach to the script left little room for the creativity the director hoped to inspire.
5. While some enjoy abstract art, he remains a literalist, preferring clear representations of reality.
