Meaning: To literalize means to interpret or express something in a literal or straightforward manner, often reducing its figurative or abstract qualities.

1. To truly understand the poem, you must avoid the temptation to literalize its metaphors.
2. The artist chose to literalize her vision through a series of vivid sculptures.
3. In his lecture, the professor cautioned against the urge to literalize abstract concepts.
4. When trying to explain the story, she found it difficult not to literalize the underlying themes.
5. The adaptation failed to capture the essence of the novel because it attempted to literalize every nuance.
