

LITMUS

Meaning: Litmus refers to a test or indicator that determines the presence or quality of a particular condition, often used in both scientific contexts, such as measuring acidity, and metaphorical contexts, such as assessing the effectiveness of a policy.

1. The litmus test for the new policy will be its impact on employee satisfaction.
2. In chemistry class, we learned how to use litmus paper to determine the acidity of various solutions.
3. His reaction to the criticism served as a litmus for how well he could handle pressure.
4. The success of the project will serve as a litmus for future funding decisions.
5. During the experiment, the litmus indicated that the solution was neutral rather than acidic or basic.
