

# LOCULUS

*Meaning: Loculus: a small compartment or cavity, especially in a biological context, used for storage or housing specific structures.*

1. The botanist carefully examined the loculus within the flower to study its reproductive structures.
2. In the ancient manuscript, the term loculus referred to a small compartment used for storing precious items.
3. Each loculus in the fossilized specimen contained remnants of organic material, offering clues about its past.
