Meaning: Locus refers to a specific location or position, particularly in genetics or psychology, where a particular gene is situated or where an individual's perception of control over events resides.

1. The locus of the gene was identified through extensive genetic mapping.
2. In psychology, the concept of locus of control explains how much individuals feel they can influence events in their lives.
3. The scientist focused on the locus of infection to develop a targeted treatment plan.
4. In urban planning, the locus of community activity often determines the location of new facilities.
5. The debate centered on the locus of responsibility in the environmental crisis.
