1. She lunged forward to catch the ball before it hit the ground.
2. The cat lunged at the toy mouse, its instincts kicking in.
3. In a moment of panic, he lunged at the door, desperate to escape.
4. The athlete lunged across the finish line, determined to win the race.
5. Startled by the sudden movement, the dog lunged at the stranger.
