

LVIGATE

Meaning: Levigate: to grind or pulverize a substance, typically in a liquid medium, to achieve a finer consistency or to separate finer particles from coarser ones.

1. The engineer decided to levigate the powder to achieve a finer consistency.
2. In order to improve the quality of the paint, the artist used a levigate process on the pigments.
3. The chemist carefully levigated the solid substance to ensure it mixed thoroughly with the solvent.
4. After levigating the ingredients, the mixture became much smoother and easier to work with.
5. The lab technician noted that levigating the sample resulted in a more uniform particle size.
