Meaning: Majority: the greater number or part of a group, typically more than half, that holds influence or decision-making power.

1. The majority of the committee voted in favor of the new policy.
2. In a democratic society, the majority often dictates the direction of governance.
3. A majority of the students expressed their desire for longer lunch breaks.
4. The majority opinion in the court case set a significant legal precedent.
5. Despite the majority support, some still raised concerns about the proposed changes.
