Meaning: To malignify means to speak about someone in a way that is intended to damage their reputation or character, often through false or misleading claims.

1. To malignify someone's character without evidence is both unethical and damaging.
2. The politician's attempt to malignify his opponent resulted in a backlash from the public.
3. It's disheartening to see how easily misinformation can malignify innocent individuals.
4. Rather than address the issue, she chose to malignify him in front of the entire team.
5. When we malignify others, we often reveal more about ourselves than the person we're criticizing.
