

MALLEOLUS

Meaning: Malleolus: a bony prominence on either side of the ankle, specifically the medial or lateral projections of the ankle bones.

1. The malleolus is a bony prominence located on either side of the ankle.
2. During the physical examination, the doctor noted swelling around the lateral malleolus.
3. Injuries to the malleolus can result in significant pain and difficulty walking.
4. The surgeon carefully examined the malleolus before proceeding with the ankle repair.
5. Anatomy students often study the malleolus to understand its role in joint stability.
