

MALPIGHIAN

Meaning: Malpighian refers to structures or cells related to the excretory system in insects or to specific types of cells in plants, named after the Italian anatomist Marcello Malpighi.

1. The Malpighian tubules in insects play a crucial role in excretion and osmoregulation.
2. Researchers discovered new functions of Malpighian cells that might influence plant growth.
3. In the study of human anatomy, the term 'Malpighian' often refers to layers of the skin.
4. The Malpighian layer of the epidermis is essential for the regeneration of skin cells.
5. Botanists frequently examine Malpighian structures to understand plant physiology better.
