Meaning: Malversation refers to the act of corruptly misusing or misappropriating funds or resources, typically in a position of authority.

1. The company's financial troubles were partly attributed to malversation by some of its top executives.
2. After an extensive investigation, the auditors uncovered malversation that had gone unnoticed for years.
3. She was charged with malversation after evidence revealed she had embezzled funds from the charity.
4. The politician's career ended abruptly when allegations of malversation surfaced during the election campaign.
5. Malversation can undermine public trust in institutions, making accountability essential.
