Meaning: Mand (verb): To order or require someone to do something.

1. The teacher will mand that all students complete their assignments by Friday.
2. During the meeting, the manager chose to mand a change in the project timeline.
3. To ensure safety, the regulations mand the use of protective gear on the job site.
4. The new policy will mand regular training sessions for all employees.
5. As part of the agreement, the company must mand certain ethical standards in its operations.
