Meaning: Manipulative refers to behavior intended to influence or control others in a deceptive or exploitative manner.

1. The therapist was cautious of the client's manipulative behavior during their sessions.
2. She found his charm to be more manipulative than genuine, making her feel uneasy.
3. In politics, manipulative tactics often overshadow honest dialogue and debate.
4. The novel's antagonist employed manipulative strategies to control the protagonist's decisions.
5. Her manipulative nature became evident when she twisted the truth to serve her own interests.
