

MANSLAUGHTER

Meaning: Manslaughter is the unlawful killing of a person without premeditation, often occurring in the heat of the moment or as a result of provocation.

1. The defendant was charged with manslaughter after the fatal altercation escalated unexpectedly.
2. In many jurisdictions, manslaughter is viewed as a less severe crime than murder, reflecting the lack of premeditation.
3. During the trial, the jury had to determine whether the act was a result of passion or a conscious decision to harm.
