Meaning: Manubrium: the broad, upper part of the sternum that connects to the clavicles and the first ribs in the human body.

1. The manubrium connects the sternum to the clavicles in the human body.
2. In anatomy class, we learned about the significance of the manubrium in rib cage structure.
3. A fracture of the manubrium can lead to severe complications in respiratory function.
4. The manubrium serves as an important landmark for identifying other thoracic structures.
5. During the dissection, we highlighted the manubrium to emphasize its role in chest anatomy.
