Meaning: MASS: a measure of the amount of matter in an object, often expressed in kilograms or grams, or a religious ceremony, particularly in Christian traditions, where worship and communion are conducted.

1. The mass of the object increased as more material was added.

3. Scientists measure the mass of particles to understand their behavior in the universe.
4. A massive crowd attended the concert, filling every inch of the venue.
