3. You may want to consider all your options before making a decision.
4. This document may need further revisions before submission.
5. He may have left the party early to get some rest.
6. I may go to the concert if I finish my work early.
7. You may find that the solution is simpler than you expected.
8. They may not realize how much effort went into the project.
9. We may consider additional options before making a decision.
10. It may rain later, so don't forget your umbrella.
11. I may go for a walk if the weather improves.
12. She may have forgotten about our meeting this afternoon.
13. You may want to consider taking a break to clear your mind.
14. They may arrive late due to traffic on the highway.
15. We may need to adjust our plans depending on the outcome of the meeting.
