

MECONIUM

Meaning: Meconium is the thick, dark green substance that constitutes the first feces of a newborn, usually passed within the first 24 hours after birth.

1. Meconium is the first stool of a newborn and typically appears within the first 24 hours of life.
2. Doctors often monitor for meconium aspiration syndrome, which can occur if a baby inhales meconium-stained amniotic fluid during birth.
3. The presence of thick meconium in the amniotic fluid can indicate fetal distress during labor.
4. After birth, the passage of meconium is a good sign that the baby's digestive system is functioning properly.
5. Health professionals may perform a meconium test to check for certain metabolic disorders in newborns.

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
