

# MESOCARP

*Meaning: Mesocarp: the fleshy middle layer of a fruit's pericarp, located between the outer exocarp and the inner endocarp.*

1. The mesocarp of a peach is the fleshy part that we enjoy eating.
2. In botanical terms, the mesocarp is the middle layer of the pericarp, situated between the exocarp and endocarp.
3. Coconuts are unique in that their mesocarp is fibrous and tough, contributing to their durability.
4. When studying fruits, understanding the role of the mesocarp can provide insights into their development and structure.
5. The sweet, juicy mesocarp of a mango is often the highlight of tropical fruit salads.
