

METACARPUS

Meaning: Metacarpus refers to the group of five long bones in the middle part of the hand that connect the wrist's carpal bones to the finger bones (phalanges).

1. The metacarpus consists of five long bones that form the middle part of the hand.
2. In hand anatomy, the metacarpus connects the carpal bones of the wrist to the phalanges of the fingers.
3. Injuries to the metacarpus can significantly affect a person's ability to grip and manipulate objects.
4. Surgeons often need to take great care when operating on the metacarpus to preserve its function.
5. Understanding the structure of the metacarpus is essential for diagnosing hand disorders.
