

METEOROID

Meaning: A meteoroid is a small rocky or metallic body in outer space, typically smaller than an asteroid, that can become a meteor upon entering a planet's atmosphere.

1. A meteoroid traveling through space can become a meteor as it enters the Earth's atmosphere.
2. Scientists study meteoroids to better understand the composition of our solar system.
3. When a meteoroid collides with Earth, it can create a crater depending on its size and speed.
4. The bright streaks we see in the night sky are often caused by small meteoroids burning up in the atmosphere.
5. Some meteoroids are remnants from comets, while others originate from asteroids.
