

MICROAMPRE

Meaning: Microampere: a unit of electric current equal to one-millionth of an ampere, commonly used to measure very small currents in electronic circuits.

1. The technician measured the current flowing through the circuit in microamperes.
2. In the lab, the sensor's output was recorded as a change in microamperes over time.
3. A microampere is often used to specify the sensitivity of electronic devices.
4. The device operates efficiently even with minimal power consumption of just a few microamperes.
5. When calibrating the equipment, the readings fluctuated between 50 and 200 microamperes.
