

# MICROCOULOMB

*Meaning: Microcoulomb is a unit of electric charge equal to one millionth ( $10^{-6}$ ) of a coulomb.*

1. A microcoulomb is a unit of electric charge equal to one millionth of a coulomb.
2. In electrostatic experiments, we often measure charges in microcoulombs for greater precision.
3. The capacitor can store up to 500 microcoulombs of charge under optimal conditions.
4. During the experiment, we recorded a discharge of approximately 250 microcoulombs.
5. Understanding microcoulombs is essential for students studying electrical engineering.
