Meaning: Middle-ground: a compromise or intermediate position that reconciles differing viewpoints or interests.

1. Finding a middle-ground between their differing opinions was crucial for a successful negotiation.
2. The committee struggled to find a middle-ground that would satisfy both sides of the debate.
3. In the joint project, they aimed to establish a middle-ground that respected both cultural perspectives.
