Meaning: Militarism is the belief in or reliance on military strength and readiness, often influencing national policy and prioritizing military over social needs.

3. The rise of militarism in the region has sparked concerns about an impending arms race among neighboring countries.
4. In literature, militarism is frequently portrayed as a destructive force that undermines human values and relationships.
5. To combat the effects of militarism, many activists advocate for a greater emphasis on diplomacy and peaceful conflict resolution.
