Meaning: To militate means to have a significant influence or effect, often in a way that opposes or supports a particular outcome or situation.

1. Poor working conditions can militate against employee productivity and morale.
2. The new evidence may militate in favor of a more thorough investigation into the case.
3. Climate change continues to militate against the long-term sustainability of many ecosystems.
4. His lack of experience could militate against his chances of being hired for the position.
5. Public opinion can militate against policies that are perceived as unfair or harmful.
