

MILLIAMPRE

Meaning: Milliampere is a unit of electric current equal to one-thousandth of an ampere.

1. A milliampere is a unit of electric current that is equal to one thousandth of an ampere.
2. When measuring the output of the device, the technician noted it was operating at a steady state of fifty milliamperes.
3. The circuit requires a current draw of two hundred milliamperes to function optimally.
