Meaning: Minyan: A quorum of ten adult Jews required for the recitation of certain communal prayers in Judaism.

1. A minyan is required for certain Jewish prayers to be recited in a communal setting.
2. In many synagogues, a minyan is formed by gathering ten adult Jews together.
3. The importance of a minyan is deeply rooted in Jewish tradition and law.
4. During the pandemic, some communities adapted by holding virtual minyanim to maintain connection.
5. Finding a minyan can be particularly challenging for Jews traveling in remote areas.
