Meaning: Misascribe: to incorrectly attribute or assign something, such as findings or quotes, to the wrong source or cause.

1. The researcher was careful to avoid any errors that might misascribe the findings to the wrong variables.
2. In the report, the author inadvertently misascribed the quote to the wrong historian, causing confusion among readers.
3. It is crucial to verify sources to ensure that we do not misascribe important contributions to the wrong individuals.
4. Her tendency to misascribe motivations to others often led to misunderstandings in their discussions.
5. The misascribe of the data in the study resulted in significant misinterpretations of the results.
