Meaning: Misassay refers to the incorrect assessment or measurement of a sample's properties or concentration in a scientific experiment.

1. The results of the experiment were questioned due to a potential misassay of the samples.
2. Inaccurate readings from the previous round led the researchers to suspect a misassay had occurred.
3. The misassay caused significant delays in the publication of the study.
4. She carefully reviewed the data to rule out the possibility of a misassay before proceeding.
