Meaning: Misattend: to fail to pay proper attention or to be present at an event or gathering, often leading to a lack of engagement or awareness.

1. The students began to misattend the lectures after realizing the material was available online.
2. His tendency to misattend important meetings often left him out of the loop.
3. They were warned that if they continued to misattend their classes, they would fail the course.
4. She couldn't believe she had misattended the annual conference, missing out on key networking opportunities.
5. Misattending a few sessions during the training could hinder your overall understanding of the program.
