Meaning: MISBESEEM: (verb) To be inappropriate or unsuitable for a particular situation or context.

1. Her behavior at the event seemed to misbeseem the expectations of her peers.
2. It would misbeseem the dignity of the occasion to act inappropriately.
3. The artist's latest work misbeseemed the traditional standards of beauty.
4. His comments on the sensitive topic misbeseemed the audience, leading to an awkward silence.
5. In that context, her casual dress misbeseemed the formal nature of the gathering.
