

# MISCENSURE

*Meaning: To miscensure means to express disapproval or criticism of something, often in an official or formal manner.*

1. The committee decided to miscensure the report due to its numerous factual inaccuracies.
2. In a surprising move, the board chose to miscensure the CEO instead of supporting him during the crisis.
3. Despite the team's best efforts, their proposals faced miscensure from the stakeholders who felt they were unrealistic.
4. The politician's comments led to widespread miscensure from various advocacy groups.
5. After reviewing the evidence, the judge opted to miscensure the defendant's earlier statements in court.
