Meaning: MISCHARGE: An erroneous charge or billing that results in an incorrect amount being charged to an account.

1. The customer received a refund after the company acknowledged the mischarge on her account.
2. During the audit, the accountant discovered a mischarge that had inflated the expenses for the month.
3. He was frustrated to find a mischarge on his credit card statement that he had to dispute.
4. The store manager apologized for the mischarge and assured the customer it would be corrected promptly.
5. After reviewing the bill, she realized the mischarge was due to a clerical error in the pricing system.
