Meaning: To misconstruct means to misunderstand or incorrectly interpret the meaning or intention of something.

1. People often misconconstruct the intentions behind someone's actions without understanding their background.
2. The architect feared that the builders might misconconstruct the original design due to unclear blueprints.
3. In discussions about complex topics, it's easy for participants to misconconstruct each other's arguments.
4. When translating literature, one must be careful not to misconconstruct the author's original meaning.
5. If you misconconstruct the data, it could lead to serious misunderstandings in your research findings.
