

# MISCONTINUANCE

*Meaning: Miscontinuance refers to the improper or premature termination of a legal proceeding or project, often due to procedural errors or unexpected circumstances.*

1. The court declared a miscontinuance of the trial due to procedural errors.
2. Her sudden miscontinuance from the project left the team scrambling for answers.
3. The miscontinuance of services during the storm caused significant disruptions.
4. After the miscontinuance of negotiations, both parties had to reassess their positions.
5. He filed a complaint regarding the miscontinuance of his subscription without notice.
