*Meaning: MISCUE: a mistake or error in action or performance that leads to an unintended outcome.*

1. The player was frustrated by the miscue that led to an easy goal for the opposing team.
2. During the rehearsal, a miscue in the dialogue caused the actors to stumble over their lines.
3. Despite her talent, a simple miscue in the performance made her feel self-conscious.
4. The orchestra recovered quickly from the miscue, impressing the audience with their professionalism.
5. He attributed his poor score to a miscue during the final round of the competition.
