Meaning: To misdeem means to judge or regard something or someone incorrectly or unjustly.

1. Some people misdeem wealth as the ultimate measure of success.
2. She misdeemed his intentions, thinking he was insincere when he was genuinely concerned.
3. It's easy to misdeem a quiet person as unfriendly, when they may just be shy.
4. The committee misdeemed the proposal, believing it lacked merit despite its potential benefits.
5. Many misdeem historical events based on misunderstandings or incomplete information.
