

# MISDEMEANANT

*Meaning: Misdemeanant: a person who has committed a minor crime or offense, typically punishable by less severe penalties than felonies.*

1. The judge sentenced the misdemeanant to community service for his minor offenses.
2. In her role as a public defender, she often represented misdemeanants who couldn't afford legal counsel.
3. The police officer explained the differences between a felon and a misdemeanant during the community meeting.
4. After the trial, the misdemeanant expressed remorse for his actions and vowed to change.
5. The legal system treats misdemeanants with less severity compared to those charged with felonies.
